



# SUMMIT NEWS LETTER





Kolu is the festive display of dolls in South India during the autumn, particularly around Navaratri, the festival of Hinduism. Displays are typically thematic, narrating a legend from a Hindu text to court life, weddings, everyday scenes, miniature kitchen utensils, anything a little girl would have played with. They are also known as Kolu, Gombe Habba, Bommai Kolu or Bommala Kolu. Kolu dolls are typically made by rural artisans from clay and wooden materials then brightly painted. They are generally arranged in an odd number of tiers to tell a story. Kolu also has a significant connection with the agricultural and handicrafts professions in India. In MPS Kolu dolls were displayed. Each tier (layer) in Kolu depict levels of knowledge. It was celebrated in a grand manner.

# Wild Life Poster



Wildlife is a general term for all wild, untamed animals. Wildlife provides stability to different processes of nature. Wildlife Week is celebrated every year in India between October 2nd and 8th, as we are stepping into urbanization, more and more wildlife is being affected. The life of the dodo came to an abrupt end in the 1600s, Quagg, African Black Rhino, Passenger Pigeon, The Great Auk and many more species are extinct. Wildlife Week was conceptualized in 1952 with the overall goal of raising awareness to serve the long-term goal of safeguarding the lives of wildlife through critical action. The Indian Government established an Indian Board of Wild Life which works to improve awareness of the preservation of wildlife. Throughout Wildlife Week, experts conduct hands-on workshops to bring the more complex aspects of wildlife conservation within the reach and understanding of all age groups. Muthamil Public School also organized poster making competitions to create awareness among students regarding the importance of wildlife. Our students participated with great zeal and devotion.

*Dr APJ Abdul Kalam*

Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam was born on 15 October 1931 to a Tamil Muslim family in the pilgrimage centre of Rameswaram on Pamban Island. He came to be known as the Missile Man of India for his work on the development of ballistic missiles and launch vehicle technology. He also played a pivotal organisational, technical, and political role in India's Pokhran-II nuclear tests in 1998, the first since the original nuclear test by India in 1974. Abdul Kalam was India's president from 25 July 2002 – 25 July 2007. He has also authored many books. He was a great man and would stay in our hearts forever. In MPS, a brief introduction about Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam was given.

Vidyarambham (Tamil: வித்யாரம்பம்) also called Akshara Abhyasam or Vidya Arambham is an important Hindu tradition that is observed on the Vijayadashami day. This ceremony is also known as 'Ezhuthiniruthu' in the southern states of India. In this ritual young children aged between 3-5 years are introduced to the world of knowledge, music, dance and some forms of folk arts. The observance of Vidyarambham is considered to be an auspicious day for initiating the learning process, especially in young children. According to the beliefs, it is on the day of Vidyarambham that Goddess Saraswati, should be presented with 'Gurudakshina' as a token for Thanksgiving. In Muthamil Public School all the kids stepping into education, tagged along with their Parents and Grandparents were invited and that day was celebrated grandly. Parents/Grandparents were asked to write the ward's name on a rice plate with Gold rings. Kids painted their hands and imprinted that on chart papers. The kids had a blissful time.




## NATIONAL UNITY DAY

SARDAR VALLABHBHAI PATEL  
(IRON MAN OF INDIA)  
131 October 1875 – 15 December 1950



Rashtriya Ekta Diwas is observed on 31st October in India and is also known as National Unity Day. The day honours the legacy of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. National Unity Day commemorates the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, India's first Home Minister, who played an important role in persuading many princely states to join the Union of India. He is famously known as Iron Man of India and as one of the founding leaders of the Republic of India. Rashtriya Ekta Diwas was inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2014, by paying tribute to the Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's statue and flagging of a program which was known as 'Run For Unity' in New Delhi. Run for unity was held to spread awareness about Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's contribution to Indian history. To bring awareness to MPS students and to keep them updated with all CBSE based activities they were asked to take the pledge on Rashtriya Ekta Divas.
