Mr. V Vishnu, I.A.S, collector of Tirunelveli district was our Chief Guest. He Inaugurated the event and spoke about how important our culture is and how we ought to preserve it. He also spoke on how different species of birds depend on the water bodies like ponds. Tahsildar Mr. Selvam from Nellai Neervalam, our Chairman Mr. Amaravel Babu, Mr. Hari Prathan from Nellai Nature club, Mr. Mathivanan from ATREE's Agasthyamalai Community Conservation Centre, and also Mr. Prabhu, AHM Govt. school, Maruthakulam shared their ideas to preserve our water bodies (Ponds, Tributaries, canals, rivers and so on). Mr. Prabhu explained about nesting and roosting birds





in the pond. Birding can be a gateway into recognizing and appreciating a wider world that was there all along. Thamirabarani river is one of the oldest rivers. As water flows non-stop throughout the year, it is one of the most fish-rich rivers in the world where the river is dominated by more than 16 native Snakehead species. Our students from grades IX-XII actively participated in all the activities conducted for the development and preservation of water bodies. Water testing was done at several points including the inflow and outflow areas of the pond. The chemical content rises as it nears the land. Chemicals are mixed in the water from the pesticides used by the farmers. They did a wonderful job by CLEANING Sirukulam at Gangaikondan and they also enjoyed the day by BIRDING. Birdwatching, or birding, is a form of wildlife observation in which the observation of birds is a recreational activity. This had a great impact on their lives and they would cherish this moment forever. All these activities were organized on Sunday and these show how zealous our students are when comes to field activities. we have involved many volunteers residing around the pond in this project.



Apiculture



Bees are one of the many insects in the world that can produce something that is beneficial to all of us. We obtain honey from these bees and as we all know, honey is an important food for human beings. Since ancient times, honey is used for treating several diseases, and it is an antioxidant, therefore beekeeping is an important activity. Bees are mainly reared for their honey. 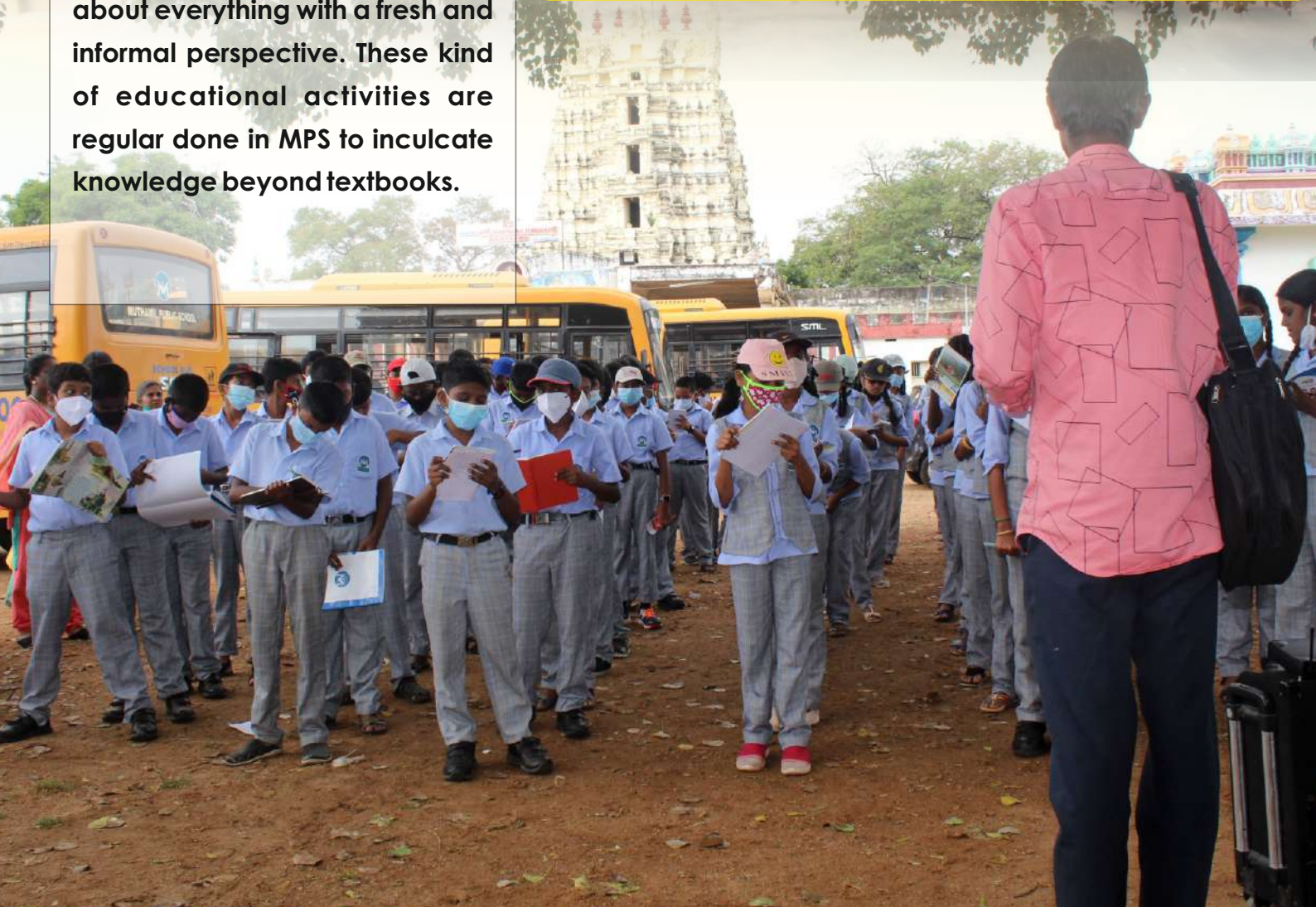
