Under CBSE Expression series MPS conducted various quiz competitions for students from grades III to XII. The topic was National War Memorial. Students could express their thoughts by Essay, Painting, or Poem writing. The War Memorial is a testament to the service, sacrifice, and loss of a century of service. Students participated with great zeal. The first level Expression series was organized in the school. For the second level, one from each category was selected and forwarded to CBSE.

To Develop and hone an innovation mindset among the students, a project-making competition was organized by MPS. The Atal Tinkering Lab (ATL) marathon is a national-level innovation challenge, where students identify community problems of their choice and develop innovative solutions in the form of working prototypes. The themes for this year are – Healthcare & Nutrition, Education, Energy and Transportation, and Social Inclusion. Two teams from each class (6th-12th) participated.

Students had to come up with their own ideas for the model. SIH wanted the students to contribute towards the nation-building initiative.

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
