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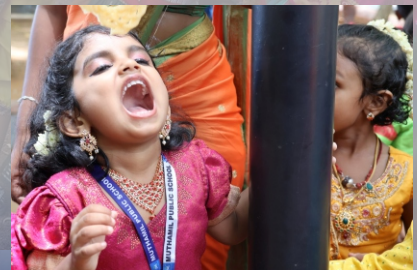

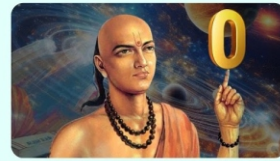
CBSE Reading Challenge 2024-25

The Aryabhata Ganit Challenge, organized by CBSE, is designed to evaluate students' proficiency in applying mathematical concepts to real-life scenarios. This initiative encourages students to think critically and creatively about mathematics beyond the classroom. Students from MPS in grades VIII to X took part in the first round of the challenge, showcasing their skills in practical problem-solving and demonstrating how mathematics can be used in everyday situations. The challenge not only enhances their mathematical understanding but also fosters a deeper appreciation for the subject as a valuable tool in daily life. Participants are eager to advance in the competition, further honing their abilities as they progress to the next rounds.

CBSE launched the Reading Challenge to foster a lifelong love of reading among students while enhancing essential skills for their academic and personal growth. MPS students from classes 6 to 10 participated in this Reading Challenge that aims to develop critical abilities such as: Reading with comprehension and accuracy- Constructing meaning by retrieving information and connecting the text to prior knowledge- Reflecting on and evaluating the text, interpreting information, and drawing logical conclusions. The first round was conducted at the school level. The top scorers will proceed to the second round which will take place in September.
