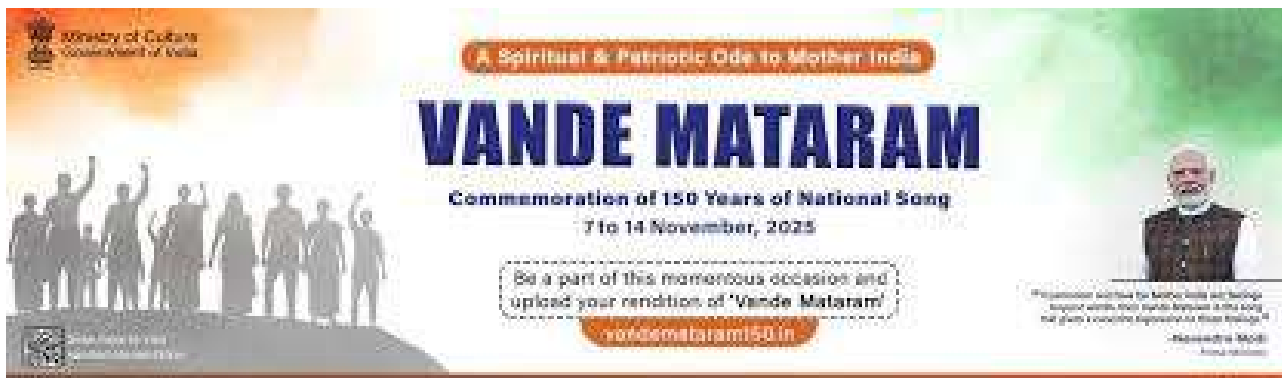
ECO CLUB – TREE PLANTATION DRIVE
