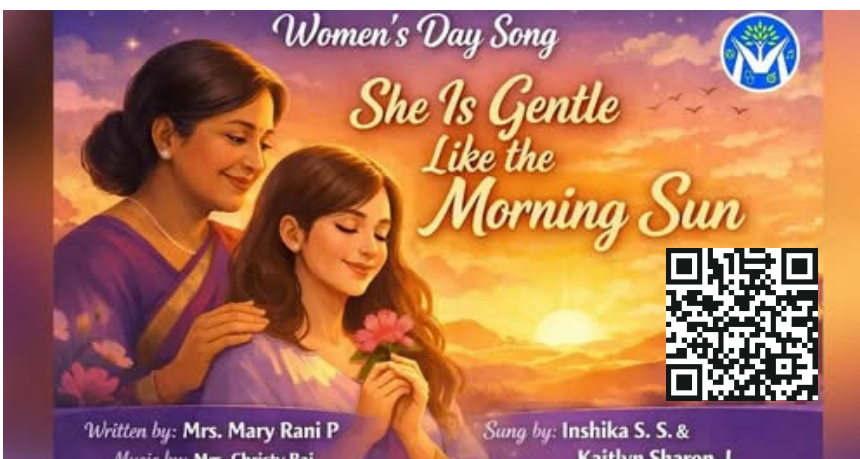

Subject: Conduct of Foundational Learning Study (FLS) 2026 – reg.

Vide letter number फा. सं. 31-6/परख/रा.मू.के./2024-25 dated 18th February, 2026 it has been informed that the Foundational Learning Study (FLS) - 2026 will be conducted by PARAKH during the end of March 2026. The study aims to assess the Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) competencies of students at the end of Grade 3, with the State/UT serving as the unit of assessment.

The Foundational Learning Study (FLS) - 2026 marks a transition from the earlier paper-pen (OMR-based) mode adopted in 2022 to a tablet-based digital platform. The adoption of the digital mode, is expected to strengthen data quality and improve the efficiency and timeliness of reporting.

The study will cover over 10,000 schools and more than 1,00,000 students across 776 districts in 36 States/UTs, including Government (Central and State), Government-aided, and Private

As per the guidelines of Central Board of Secondary Education, the Foundational Learning Study (FLS) 2026 will be conducted to assess foundational literacy and numeracy skills of Grade III students. This nationwide study, led by PARAKH under NCERT, will be carried out using a digital platform, marking a significant step towards improved assessment practices. The initiative aims to strengthen early learning outcomes and support better educational planning across schools.
