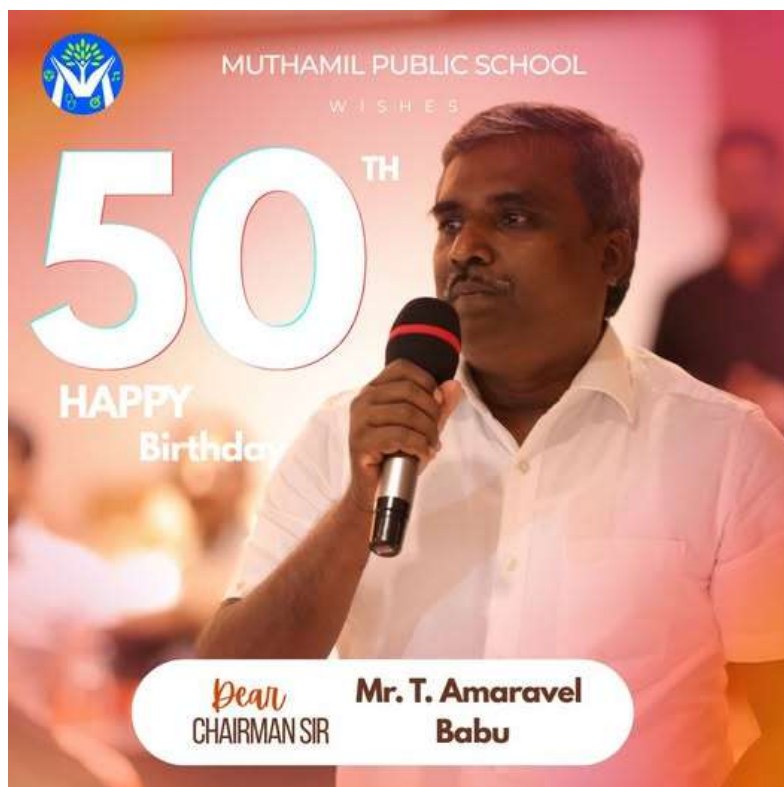


Scooping Activity

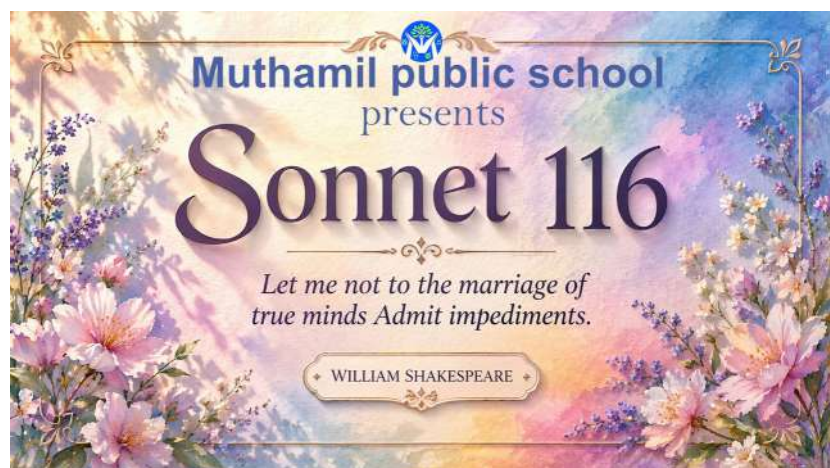
